

SPVU-5D - Preference based utility instrument for venous ulcers

The SPVU-5D is a new condition-specific preference-based measure of health related quality of life for use in the assessment of the impact of venous ulceration. It has five dimensions encompassing physical, psychological and social aspects. The dimensions have between three and five levels. Preferenceweights and a scoring algorithm were produced based on valuations from the UK population
